DVD Library Letter (July, 2010)

We have two new DVD's for rental this month. The first is #D219. It's a stark departure from our normal fare, as this one concerns the bandsaw. Since the tool that we use most in conjunction with our lathes is the bandsaw, I thought that one DVD on that subject wouldn't be too great a waste of money. It shows the basics of using, maintaining, and adjusting the tool for best results. So when you're trying to round that 30 pound square chunk into something approaching round, the information on this disk just might make the job easier. And safer.

The second is #D220, and is titled "Turning Acrylic Materials" by Barry Gross. While geared primarily towards pen turning, it covers other aspects of acrylic turning as well, such as casting your own blanks, finishing and drilling.

NOTA BENE!!

If you're considering, or have been considering, renting any particular DVD, this month is the time to do it. When you rent the DVD, you'll be given a slip on which you'll write the DVD number.
