He shows how to make chair parts, an offset foot, knobs and cabinet knobs, and how to duplicate parts for production work. Those of you that may do this type of work should find this disc informative.

The second is D232, and is the 4th in our series of the Florida Woodturning Symposium. Nick Cook turns a very nice ash platter with a burned rim. He also demo's the Sorby texturing tool on a European beech dish.

The second demo on this disc is by Michael Mocho. Again, the camera work on this video leaves something to be desired. (Makes me appreciate our own Roger Cartier more and more!) I decided to offer it to our members anyway, since he does provide a wealth of information on chatter work, showing not only how to, but why. He also shows a simple method of embossing.
